

Bishop's Heart Choose Love

Dr. Lisa Firestone, a psychologist and co-author of Sex and Love in Intimate Relationships, said "the best way to think of love is as a verb. Love is dynamic and requires action to thrive. At times it may feel frustrating, but it's actually pretty empowering to accept the fact that the only person we have any true control over in a relationship is ourselves." Although our desire for human relationship is inate, the ability to have a loving relationship is a learned behavior. Since love is one of the most powerful human emotions to mankind we must learn to develop and maximize our ability to love and be loved. Paul said in Romans 5:5,8 "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us... God showed his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Paul shows us how love is developed in us in two ways. When we believe that God's love is poured out in his Son, then the Holy Spirit pours out God's love in our hearts. This is why I John 4:8-9 says

"He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him." Love is developed and manifested in our lives through knowing Christ. The more we love Christ, the more we love others. We love because He first loved us. The more weexperience the love of Christ filling our hearts, the more we will be able to love others well. The more we are filled with the love of God, the greater our capacity to be a loving spouse, child, friend, relative, co-worker, neighbor and church member. Love is the center of it all! Learning to love is one of our major tasks in life. Our love is often tested and even strengthen through adversity. Since God chose us in love (Ephesians 1:4), then we should be "rooted and grounded in love" (Ephesians 3:17), "bearing with one another in love" (Ephesians 4:2), "speaking the truth in love" (Ephesians 4:15), "building up the body of Christ in love," (Ephesians 4:16) and "walking in love." (Ephesians 5:2) Let us choose to love as well!
