# Bishop's Heart

## Don't Worry

Worrying is dangerous! It is a medical fact that over 51 diseases can be traced directly to worry! There are people who constantly worry about money, their job and their health and anything else they can think of. Their anxiety becomes so all-embracing that it takes over their whole lives. Instead of worrying, we must learn to look around in faith and see what opportunities God is giving us to serve Him.

People who don't worry as much as others are often called careless, carefree, happy go lucky, insensitive, unconcerned and out of touch with reality and life. However, God does not want us to worry and He teaches us how to live a worry free life. Worry is proportional to our sense of security. How much we worry is based upon how insecure we are. When we worry, our faith is diminished. Solomon must have been speaking of the uselessness of worry when he wrote, "Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the Lord guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain. It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows; for so He gives His beloved sleep." (Psalm 127:1-2) When something occurs in our lives that we cannot control, most of us worry. When something appears on the horizon of our lives that looks bad, even though it may or may not happen, many people tend to worry. We worry about big things, and we worry about little things. The point is, many of us to some degree - worry!

We cannot stop trouble, chaos, danger and problems from coming, but we can trust God. Worrying will not slow down whatever we have to face or go through. Proverbs 12:25 says "Worry weighs a person down; an encouraging word cheers a person up." Instead of worrying, we should exercise our kingdom power and speak faith. If we put our faith in the things of the world we are bound to be anxious about tomorrow's world. If our faith is placed in our all-loving, all-knowing, all powerful God, who taught us to cast all our care upon Him, for He careth for us (I Peter 5: 7), we will know peace of mind. Placing our lives at His disposal, we know that He works in everything for our good. (Romans 3: 28) Don't worry, God's got this too!

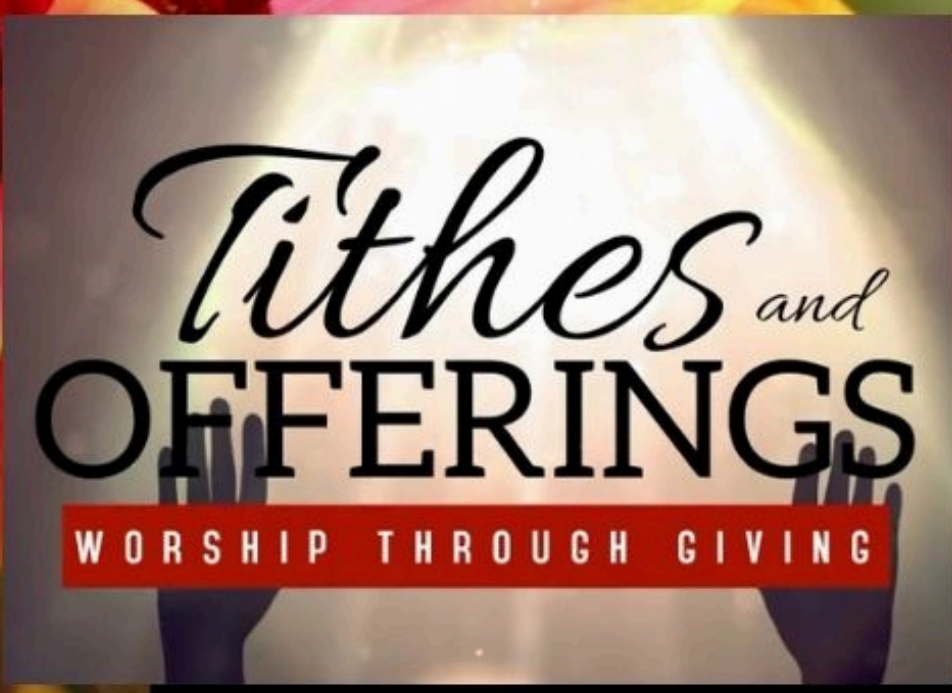

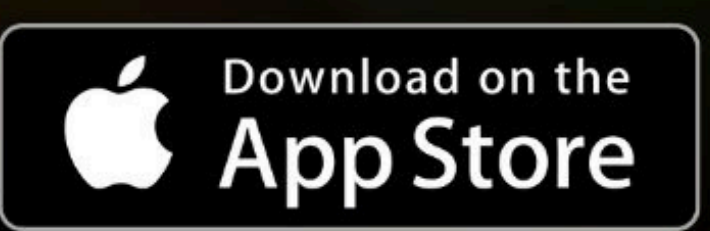

# Encouraging Corner with CoPastor

## Fasting For Results

As a bona fide daddy's girl nothing made my heart leap more than the look of approval on my daddy's face. It's nothing I can adequately explain but I loved and still love my daddy. He was the first man I ever loved. I wanted to be wherever he was. He taught me how to play basketball and tackle football, he taught me how to catch a softball and I was the apple of his eye - behind my mom of course. We were raised in what is now considered "the old school way." My brother and I were expected to do our chores with excellence, make good grades, be kind and respectful, and obey. My dad was a man of few words, my mom was not- but when he spoke my brother and I paid special attention. He stood about 6'5" and he was a giant of a man, but quiet and strong. He was **that** uncle, **that** brother that **everyone** loved and took very very seriously. He loved his family and we loved him. We made it our business to be obedient, for the most part because the alternative was not good for our emotional or physical well-being. My dad was a good dad and I loved him until the day he left us suddenly to be with the Lord. So, in his absence, I am equally, if not more, in love with my Heavenly Father, who is everything to me, and like a true daddy's girl, I love to have His approval and blessing on my life. Moreover, I do not like to grieve His heart. I live to please Him and do His will although I fall short many times.

I recently read this little excerpt from an article and it really affirmed my thinking as we complete the second week of our 40-day fast-"Fasting, like prayer, is not an effort to overcome the unwillingness of God. Fasting is learning to align our desires with God's. To allow our physical hunger to reveal to us the depth of our spiritual need.

The mistake that God's people make in Isaiah 58 is fasting without obedience. They are then surprised to find that God has not paid attention to their prayer and fasting.

Fasting that God desires is not a box we tick. It represents an entire realignment of our desires, affections, and obedience. If we are to return to the Lord in fasting, and with all our hearts (Joel 2:12), we cannot neglect obedience to all that God commands.

However, where there is alignment between our spiritual discipline (fasting), and our love for others, God stands up and pays attention! (58:6-8)"

So Lent is not just what we do in the confines of our practices and habits. Lent ought to spill over into our love for those whom God has placed around us. I'm convinced that when we line up we can move the heart of God then His ear and hand follow. What an awesome feeling to fast to get these kinds of results understanding that the greatest result is being in leaning into a more close relationship with Him, having His approval, and living as He commands. Let's please Him!
